2014 – (Four Complaints received; Four Actions taken.)

- Tom Busch: <u>Violation</u>: Unlicensed practice of forestry and offering forestry services to the general public without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to cease and desist including closing or prominently displaying on each page of the <u>www.timberlandassociates.com</u> website that he is not a Registered Forester in the State of Mississippi. <u>Effective Date</u>: June 20, 2014
- Derek Fayard: <u>Violation</u>: Offering forestry services to the general public without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to cease and desist. <u>Effective Date</u>: June 12, 2014.
- Ralph Franks: <u>Violation</u>: Unlicensed practice of forestry without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to consent order to cease and desist from engaging in any activity that constitutes the practice of forestry as defined in Section 73-36-03 and paid an administrative penalty of \$2,800.00 and administrative cost of \$2,800.00. <u>Effective Date</u>: September 30, 2014.
- Rhondl T. Ryals: <u>Violation</u>: Unlicensed practice of forestry without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to consent order to cease and desist from engaging in any conduct/activity that constitutes the practice of forestry as defined in Section 73-36-03. <u>Effective date</u>: June 11, 2014.

2015 – (Two Complaints received; One Action taken.)

 Sterling Coleman: <u>Violation</u>: Unlicensed; offering to practice forestry and using or advertising a title or description tending to convey the impression that he is a forester without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to and signed written cease and desist order from engaging in practicing or offering to practice forestry and from using the title of forester. <u>Effective</u> <u>Date</u>: December 21, 2015.

2016 - (Two Complaints received; One Action taken.)

 Scott Lindsey, RF#1686 – expired 2013: <u>Violation</u>: Offering to practice forestry and using or advertising a title or description tending to convey the impression that he is a forester without being duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent paid a \$500.00 administrative fine. <u>Effective Date</u>: September 26, 2016.

2017 – (Two Complaints received; One Action taken.)

1. **Cole Pierce:** <u>Violation:</u> Unlicensed, offering to practice forestry and using or advertising a title or description tending to convey the impression that he is a forester without being

duly registered as prohibited by Section 73-36-05. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent agreed to and signed written cease and desist order from engaging in practicing or offering to practice forestry. <u>Effective Date</u>: May 3, 2017.

2018 - (Four Complaints received; One Action taken.)

 Sterling Coleman: <u>Violation</u>: Unlicensed practice of forestry prohibited by Section 73-36-35 and 26, also not being duly registered prohibited by Section 73-36-5. <u>Disciplinary</u> <u>Action</u>: Respondent agreed to and signed a written cease and desist order from engaging in practicing or offering to practice forestry. <u>Effective Date</u>: March 14, 2018.

2019 – (Four Complaints received; Two Actions taken.)

- Ronald Jeffrey Windham, RF #1672: <u>Violation</u>: Solicitation of bids and proposed sale of timber per Rules 9.2, 9.6 and 9.8 of the Board's Administrative Rules and Code of Ethics per Sections 73-36-19, 73-36-33 and 73-13-35. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondent was fined \$3,000.00, license suspended for 90 days and requested to complete an Ethics and Contract course approved by the Board. <u>Effective Date</u>: April 20, 2022. <u>NOTE</u>: Due to COVID restrictions this case was delayed for action until 2022.
- Alan Douglas Rone, RF #1256: <u>Violation</u>: Code of Ethics. <u>Disciplinary Action</u>: Respondents license was suspended for six months and required to complete continuing forestry education in Ethics and Contract Law. <u>Effective Date</u>: July 20, 2022. <u>NOTE</u>: This case was reopened 2019 from a 2013 case and due to COVID restrictions this case was delayed for action until 2022.
